STANDING ORDER REGARDING MOTIONS FOR CONTINUANCE

Generally: Parties are responsible for stipulating cases to trial calendars pursuant to the Uniform Superior Court Rules. After a case is stipulated to the trial calendar, continuances of any trial, pretrial conference, or other hearing will be granted only on the basis of exceptional circumstances. No such continuances will be granted except by motion and shall require an order of the Court.

Absences of Witnesses: Motions for continuance on account of absence of any witness must show the steps that have been taken to secure the attendance of the witness and must reveal the nature of the witness' testimony. The motion must also state the time at which the witness will be available and, unless waived, must include a certificate of a doctor when illness of the witness is claimed. The stipulation of the adversary as to the witness' testimony shall be sufficient reason for the denial of the motion for continuance.
