STANDING ORDER REGARDING CRIMINAL CALENDARS

WHEREAS, each Judge of the Superior Court of Paulding County has regularly scheduled criminal calendars, and

WHEREAS, such matters as motions, pleas, and probation revocation hearings are placed on such calendars, and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Court that scheduling of such matters has become an issue.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Clerk of Superior Court shall prepare and publish an arraignment calendar, for each scheduled criminal motion court date, for each respective Judge. The Clerk of Superior Court shall place all cases, in which an accusation, special presentment, or indictment has been filed since the last arraignment date on such calendar and shall notify the defendants and attorneys of such arraignment date and time. All arraignments shall be set for 8:30 a.m. on such motion calendar date.

At the conclusion of the call of an arraignment calendar, the District Attorney shall provide a written list (case number and defendant name) of all cases in which the arraignment was continued. Any case, in which the arraignment was continued for any reason, shall be placed back on an *arraignment calendar* and notice of such new arraignment date and time given by the Clerk to the defendants and attorneys.

IT IS FUTHER CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that the Clerk shall prepare and publish the criminal motion court calendar for each scheduled court date for each respective Judge. Such matters as have been set by rule nisi shall be placed on a criminal motion court calendar. No matter shall be placed on the next pending criminal motion court calendar after 12:00 p.m., noon, on the second (2nd) Friday preceding the scheduled criminal motion court day EXCEPT by permission of the Judge to which the case or motion has been assigned by

written order or rule nisi. All motions shall be set for hearing at 1:30 p.m. on the respective motion court calendar.


The District Attorney of the Paulding Judicial Circuit, Circuit Public Defender or private attorney shall provide a list of any proposed guilty pleas to be placed on any particular plea calendar, and he shall do so by 12:00 noon on the Wednesday preceding the scheduled criminal motion court. The Clerk shall consolidate any lists and attach such to the criminal motion calendar. No proposed plea of guilty shall be added to such calendar after 12:00 noon on the Wednesday preceding the scheduled motion court EXCEPT by permission of the Judge holding such motion court by written order or rule nisi. No matter shall be placed on a plea calendar except by stipulation.

All notifications of matters to be placed on a plea calendar shall made in writing with the original of such writing delivered to the Clerk within the time limits previously specified. *Email shall not be sufficient notification that any plea, motion, or other hearing has been stipulated to any calendar.*


All rules nisi for matters to be placed on the criminal motion calendar shall be promptly filed with the Clerk within the time limits previously specified.

EXCEPT BY ORDER OF THE COURT, the Clerk shall not place any matter on the criminal motion calendar or plea calendar unless notice is given to the Clerk in the specified manner and within the specified time limits.
