## **Outdoor Burning Banned in Paulding County**

**Dallas, Georgia – May 1, 2019** – Effective on Tuesday, May 1<sup>st</sup>, the State of Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has issued a ban for all outdoor burning in Paulding County.

The 2018 ban is expected to last between May 1st and September 30<sup>th</sup> unless weather and drought conditions dictate otherwise.

During this period, the EPD <u>prohibits</u> the burning of limbs, leaves or any other yard debris.

Campfires for recreational purposes are permitted. However, campfires must be contained in a ring or pit and no larger than 3 feet by 3 feet and must be attended by an adult at all times.
