## **Paulding County Lifts Temporary Burning Ban**

**Dallas, Georgia – October 16, 2019** – Following much needed rainfall Paulding County has lifted the temporary outdoor burning ban.

After consulting with the Georgia Forestry Commission's Chief Ranger for Paulding County, it was determined moisture conditions have improved significantly. Therefore, PCFD's Chief Pelfrey lifted the county-wide burning ban which had been instituted on September 30<sup>th</sup>.
