ORDER REVISING PAULDING JUDICIAL CIRCUIT CORONAVIRUS
HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of the State of Georgia's Order Declaring Statewide Judicial Emergency expired at 11:59 p.m. on June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, in response to the expiration of the Order Declaring Statewide Judicial Emergency, on June 29, 2021, this Court issued an Order that, in part, established revised Paulding Judicial Circuit Coronavirus Health and Safety Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has issued new guidance regarding the wearing of masks to reduce the risk of being infected with and possibly spreading the Delta variant; and

WHEREAS, this Court is authorized to adopt orders or guidelines addressing matters of court operations and management, including, but not limited to, public health precautions within the Paulding County Judicial Circuit;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that effective upon the filing of this Order and until further order, the Paulding Judicial Circuit Coronavirus Health and Safety Guidelines are revised to require ALL employees and visitors to the Paulding County Courthouse to wear a mask covering the nose and mouth while in the building and when interacting with others; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, all employees and visitors will be subject to automated temperature screening upon entrance into the building. Any employee or visitor having a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be admitted. Any person who enters the building is certifying that he or she is free of COVID-19 symptoms and known exposure that poses a significant threat of infection.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court Administrator shall post this Order on the public notification site and in the courthouse;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the undersigned shall immediately notify and serve a copy of this Order on the judges and clerks of all courts sitting within this judicial circuit; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the undersigned shall give notice of the issuance of this Order, on the affected parties, counsel for the affected parties, and the public.


