
STANDING ORDER REGARDING WAIVERS OF ARRAIGNMENT

In order to facilitate a more orderly arraignment of criminal cases and to insure that counsel and parties are properly informed, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that in all felony cases, waivers of arraignment shall be signed by the defendant and the defendant's counsel of record. The filing of a waiver shall in no way extend the time for filing motions beyond the time specified in Unif. Super. Ct. R. 31.1. No waivers shall be accepted for filing unless signed as specified unless waived by the Court. No waivers by fax will be accepted.
