STANDING ORDER ON INJUNCTIVE RELIEF IN DOMESTIC RELATIONS CASES

All parties in each divorce or domestic relations cases in which injunctive relief of any character is requested in the Superior Court of Paulding County are subject to this order from the date and time of filing suit in each case, to-wit:

1. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from causing or permitting the minor children of the parties to be removed from the jurisdiction of this Court, interfering with the custodial status of the minor children as it was at the time of separation or the right of the parent who had been the primary provider of care for said children from continuing to have custody until further order, and preventing reasonable visitation or contact between any of said children and the non-custodial parent.

2. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from doing, or attempting to do, or threatening to do, any act of injuring, maltreating, vilifying, molesting, or harassing the adverse party or any of the children of the parties.

3. Each party is hereby enjoined and restrained from selling, encumbering, contracting to sell, or otherwise disposing of or removing from the jurisdiction of the Court, any of the property belonging to the parties, except in the ordinary course of business.

4. This order shall be binding upon the parties in the above styled action filed in the Superior Court of Paulding County, their agents, servants, employees, and all other persons acting in concert with said parties.


IT IS ORDERED, that a copy of this order be entered in each domestic relations case in which injunctive relief is sought in the Superior Court of Paulding County by the Clerk immediately upon the filing of each domestic relations complaint and that a copy of be attached to each complaint for service upon every defendant in such case.
