

ORDINANCE 20-06
TERMINATION OF CHAIRMAN'S
DECLARATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020 at 10:35 a.m., the Chairman of the Paulding County Board of Commissioners declared a county-wide State of Emergency as a result of the COVID-19 Pandemic as set forth in Ordinance 20-03; and


WHEREAS, after the passage of nearly ten weeks since its enactment, it is no longer necessary for the provisions of the Chairman's Declaration of a State of Emergency to continue at the County level; and

WHEREAS, Governor Kemp's State Public Health Emergency is currently in effect until 11:59 P.M. on July 12, 2020, and the state-wide provisions therein are sufficient to address the remaining concerns of the COVID-19 pandemic within Paulding County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Chairman's March 26, 2020 Declaration of a State of Emergency within Paulding County is hereby **TERMINATED** in its entirety, and all provisions contained therein are no longer in effect.

This Order shall become effective immediately and shall be placed in the Official Records of the Paulding County Clerk.
